

Blended Learning Program

Standard First Aid with CPR/AED level C

How does it work?

- Participants will complete all of the theory based portions of the course online, working at their own pace.
- Upon completion of the online portion they will attend a one day skills training session with a qualified Blended Learning Instructor.
- Participants must attend the in-class skills training day **within 4 weeks** of completing the online portion.
- Participants will receive their Standard First Aid with CPR/AED Level C certificate at the end of the in-class skills training day.

Registering for a Blended Learning Course

1. Review the schedule to find a course date that suits you, and fill out the registration form as normal.
2. **The cost is \$105.** (This is a \$30 savings compared to traditional SFA/CPR-C). Payment must be received in full before the registration can be completed.
3. Once payment is confirmed, arrangements will be made in order to get you the course manual so that you may start the course.
4. You will also receive an email within 1-2 business days after registration. This email will contain login information and steps to access the online portion of the course.
5. Once you are finished the online portion, you will print and bring your proof of completion to the in-class session.

Reminder: You must attend an in-class session within four weeks of the completion date on the online certificate. If you are unable to provide this document to the instructor on the morning of the in-class session, you will not be allowed to participate on that day and will have to reschedule. If you are unable to complete the in-class portion within the 4 weeks, you will have to start the on-line portion again.

FAQ's

- **What is the cost of the course?**

↳ \$105. This price includes HST.

- **How long does the online portion take?**

↳ The online portion is self-paced so completion times will vary, but in most cases will require 6 – 8 hours to complete. The advantage, is that this does not need to be completed in one sitting. The online training will save your progress each time you logout so that you can pick up right where you left off, allowing you to navigate the course at your optimal convenience.

- **How long does the in class portion take?**

↳ 8 hours.

- **How do I login to do the online portion?**

↳ Within 1-2 business days of registering, you will receive an email containing your login information and course confirmation, and further instructions to assist you complete the course.

- **What happens if I miss the skills training day?**

↳ You have 4 weeks from the time you complete your online portion until your Skills day. If you miss your training day you will need to find another skills session to attend within that 4 weeks. If you can't, your online certificate will expire, and you will have to take the entire course again.

- **Can I take a CPR only course, re-certification course, or Emergency First Aid course through Blended Learning?**
